

Access Requirements for 20 Illawong Building Site

Everyone

No person may enter site without completing a minimum of 72 hours prior the Veyor registration and induction process and receiving a notice of approval. You only need to complete this process once.

Once registration and induction is completed and approval is granted, you will receive a notification via email from Veyor.

Step by step instructions on how to complete the induction are in the 4-minute video on this website. This can be done via Smart Phone or on any computer.

The induction material refers to SafeWork NSW PPE requirements. This is a legal requirement. No person may go onto the site without the following (*can be purchased at Bunnings*).

- ✓ Hi-Vis Vest
- ✓ Steel Capped Footwear
- ✓ Hard Hat



On arrival to the site, scan the QR Code located on the glass door at the front of the building.



Individual Owners (Visitors)

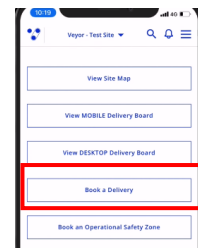
Owners wishing to visit their units **WITHOUT** an approved licensed builder/tradesperson need to be accompanied by Terry and therefore must book a 15-minute timeslot via the Veyor booking system on the app within the following times:

- 3.30 pm - 5.00 pm Tuesdays
- 3.30 pm - 5.00 pm Thursdays
- 11.00 am - 1.30pm Saturdays

Book 72 hours prior to your timeslot using **BOOK A DELIVERY** option.

Instructions to Book Owner Site Visit



Owners wishing to visit their units **WITH** a licensed builder/tradesperson with public liability insurance do not need to book a timeslot but do need to be accompanied by their approved builder.

Builders

Complete the Veyor registration and induction process and attach relevant information as specified on the Veyor App, wait for approval.

Banking Lenders/Mortgage Brokers/Valuers

If you have a lender who wishes to access the site, they should complete the registration and induction process.
